- 4. If the tour is cancelled due to any unavoidable circumstances (like Strike, Natural Calamity, Cancellation of Train, etc.), Passengers shall have to pay 25% of the Tour Cost excluding Train/Air tickets.
- 5. If any Bus Tickets, Train Tickets/Flight tickets are booked, the cancellation of the same will be refunded as per the regulation of India Railways/Airlines operators/Bus Operators. TRC Tours & Travels will not be liable for refund of the cancelled tickets.
- 6. No refund in tour price will be allowed for the untravelled portion of the tour either of sickness or any other reason.
- 7. No claim for any rescheduling will be entertained when the passenger doesn't arrive at the station/airport/bus stand before departure of the train/flight/bus for which reservation has been made. In such cases, passengers may join next of subsequent station at their own cost.
- 8. If complete payment is not received prior to 10 days of the journey, the booking will be treated as cancelled and no refund will be initiated.
